

Add stress to sounds

- "introduce": pronounced with a stress at the end "in-tro-DUCE."
- "PREsent,"(noun) "right this moment" or "a gift."
- "preSENT," (Verb) "to give or show."
- "ADDress" (noun)
- "addRESS" (Verb)
- Sentences have stresses too; "I ate some toast with butter in the morning."
