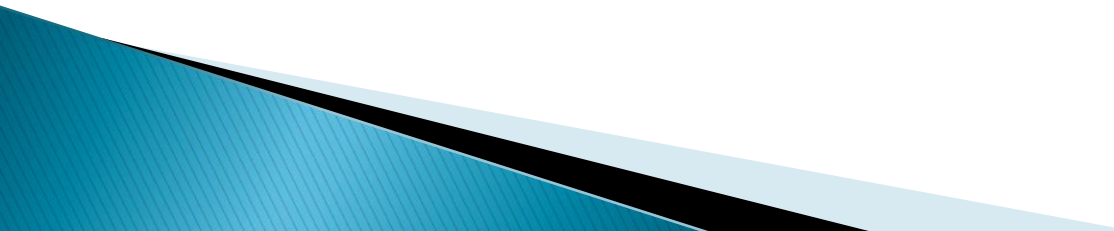

Add stress to sounds

- ▶ **“introduce”** : pronounced with a stress at the end **“in-tro-DUCE.”**
- ▶ **“PREsent,”** (noun) “right this moment” or “a gift.”
- ▶ **“preSENT,”** (Verb) “to give or show.”
- ▶ **“ADDress”** (noun)
- ▶ **“addRESS”** (Verb)
- ▶ Sentences have stresses too; “I **ate** some **toast** with **butter** in the **morning.**”
